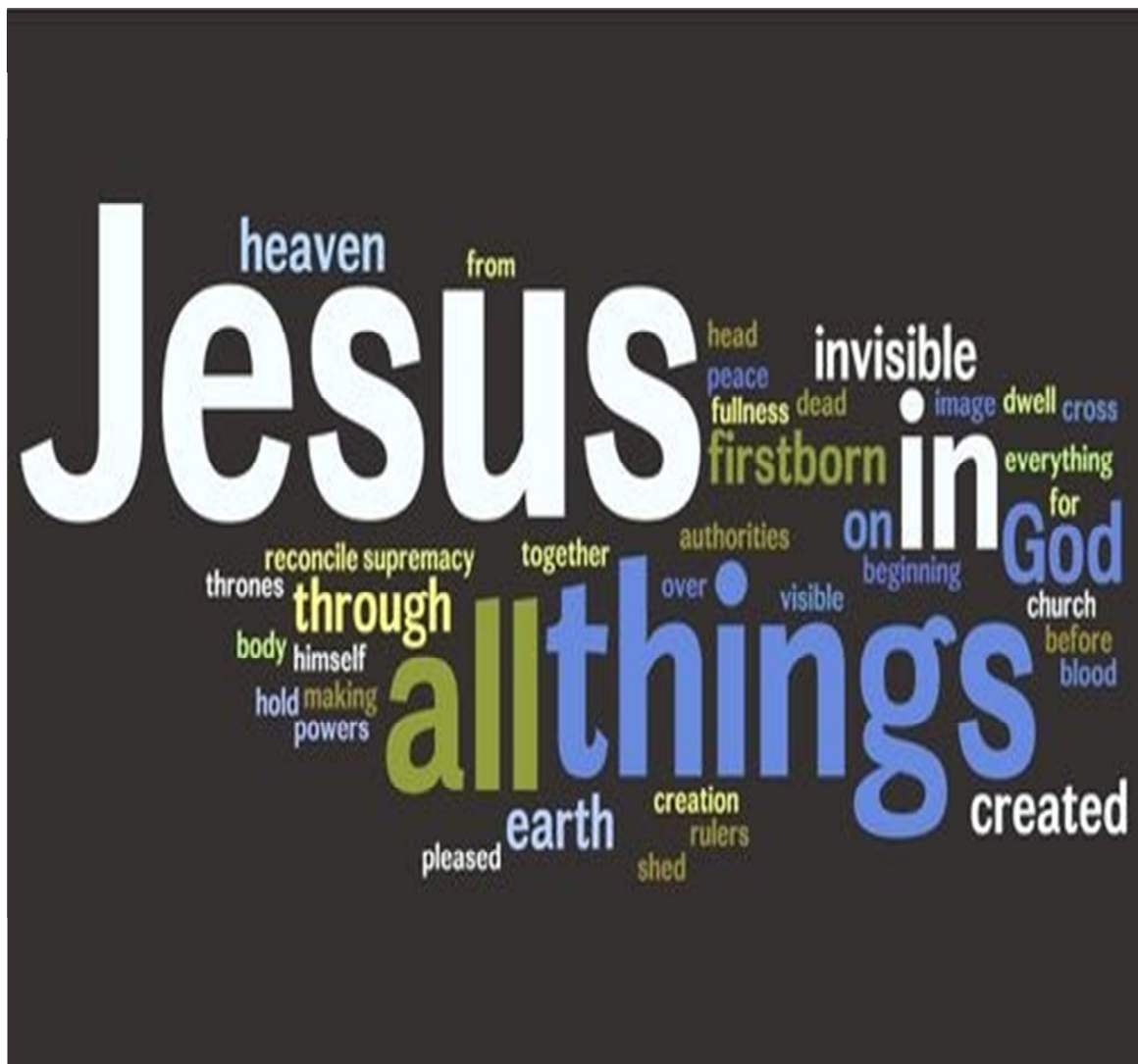


## Partners in Prayer

### Colossians 1:15 (NKJV)

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.



Here are some steps that you may want to use to help you move into a place of prayer and intercession.

1. **Come with a clean heart:** Psalm 66:18 if I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear.
2. **Die to our own thoughts:** 2 Cor. 10:5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ
3. **Silence the Enemy:** Romans 16:20 And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
4. **Invite the Holy Spirit to reveal the heart and Mind of God :** Jude 1:20 But you, dear friends, must continue to build your lives on the foundation of your holy faith. And continue to pray as you are directed by the Holy Spirit.
5. **Wait, to hear what God Says:** John 10:4 And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.
6. Then pray and intercede for what he has spoken to you about

## Day One

### Christ formed in you

#### Colossians 1:15-23 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

<sup>16</sup> For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

<sup>17</sup> And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

<sup>18</sup> And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the pre-eminence.

<sup>19</sup> For it pleased *the Father that* in Him all the fullness should dwell,

<sup>20</sup> and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

<sup>21</sup> And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled

<sup>22</sup> in the body of His flesh through death, **to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight--**

<sup>23</sup> if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.

#### Galatians 4:19 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> My little children, for whom I labour in birth again until Christ is formed in you,

**Take some time to read and meditate on the above passage and verse.**

**Consider where He and his image is being formed in you. Remember the changes God has made in your life.**

**Thank him for the change in your life.**

**Look forward to the continued formation of Christ in you. Pray for this in your own life**

**Pray for us corporately that we may represent Christ here, in Worcester and on the earth.**

**Thank Him for where we are representing Him. In our homes, work, school, communities.**

## Day Two

### We shall be like Him

#### 1 John 3:1-3 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

<sup>2</sup> Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

<sup>3</sup> And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

#### Matthew 5:1-9 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him.

<sup>2</sup> Then He opened His mouth and taught them, saying:

<sup>3</sup> "Blessed *are* the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>4</sup> Blessed *are* those who mourn, For they shall be comforted.

<sup>5</sup> Blessed *are* the meek, For they shall inherit the earth.

<sup>6</sup> Blessed *are* those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.

<sup>7</sup> Blessed *are* the merciful, For they shall obtain mercy.

<sup>8</sup> Blessed *are* the pure in heart, For they shall see God.

<sup>9</sup> Blessed *are* the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God.

**Take some time to look at the promises of God in these passages. Meditate on them let them infiltrate our thinking.**

**We are the children of God**

**We shall be like Him**

**We are the sons of God**

**Do you have this hope? This purifies you.**

**Pray for this to become more real to us individually and corporately.**

## Day Three

### ***And the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God***

#### **Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)**

<sup>20</sup> I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

#### **John 1:1-14 (KJV)**

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

<sup>2</sup> The same was in the beginning with God.

<sup>3</sup> All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made.

<sup>4</sup> In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

<sup>5</sup> And the light shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

<sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God, whose name *was* John.

<sup>7</sup> The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all *men* through him might believe.

<sup>8</sup> He was not that Light, but *was sent* to bear witness of that Light.

<sup>9</sup> *That* was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

<sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

<sup>11</sup> He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

<sup>12</sup> **But as many as received him, to them he gave power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:**

<sup>13</sup> Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

<sup>14</sup> And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

***The promises of what He gives us to live like Jesus and to become like him are, His faith and His power. These are both incredible gifts to us.***

**Spend some time thanking God for the power to live and for His gift of faith.**

**Meditate on these on these verses and let the Holy Spirit reveal His truth to you.**

**How much time do we spend trying hard to do things in our own strength?**

**What does us being crucified with Christ really mean?**
